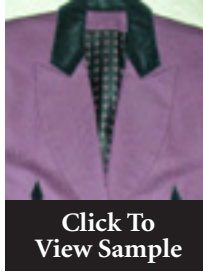
TAILORING 3: SUIT MAKING *Annette L Hickman*
